Summary: Dartmouth College is the smallest Ivy League college and the only one in northern New England. It is located in the Upper Connecticut River Valley near the border with Vermont. The school was founded by Eleazer Wheelock, a Puritan minister, to train Native American missionaries for work among their people in present-day New Hampshire and Vermont, but the school has had no religious affiliation for many years. About 19% of the student population is from New England. A PCA church plant in the area was discontinued in 2007.
