Keene, New Hampshire

Summary: Keene is the county seat of Cheshire County and the home of Keene State College. Its population is white, young, and generally less affluent than others in New Hampshire. The city is very active in environmental concerns, having become one of the first towns in the nation to adopt a plan to respond to climate change. Evangelical Christians make up approximately 3% of the population of Cheshire County. There is an [Orthodox Presbyterian Church](#) in Jaffrey (18 miles southeast) and an [independent reformed church](#) in Westmoreland (9 miles west).
